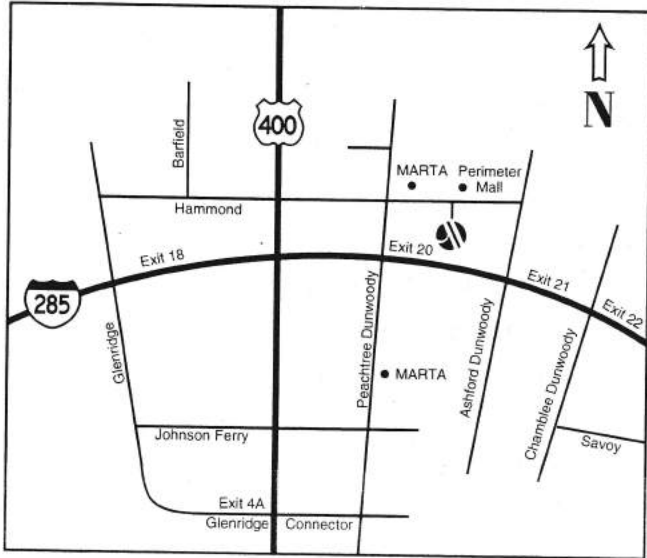


TRANSPORTATION DIRECTIONS TO OUR HOTEL:

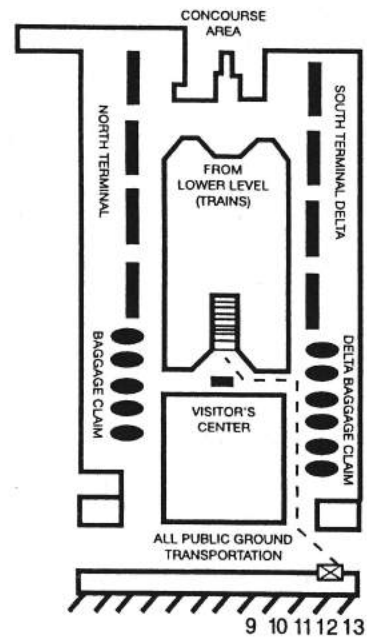

INSIGNIA

Many were concerned when they received their ancestor pins in the form of the bent arrow. It was little less than Caldwell's usual work and it was not what had been the agreement between us and Mr. Johnson. Some changes have been made with the cooperation of Mrs. Fisher and we think you will be happier with the change. The ancestor pin will be a straight bar as you have with your DAC pins. These will hold more letters and you can fill up your beautiful CSDIW ribbons with lots of ancestors. Those who have received the bent arrow are asked to return them to Caldwell and the new bar will be mailed to you. We are sorry for this inconvenience and hope you understand.

SCHOLARSHIP

Mrs. Chamberlain reported some new and exciting additions to our scholarship ways and means. There will be a "Running Horse" for a gift of \$1000.00 and a gold miniature horse tie tac for a \$25.00 gift. There are some explanations on the ways you may receive the Running Horse and the Indian Head. A State or Chapter may receive a Running Horse if it has ten members each purchasing a feather or two members purchasing an Indian Head each. This Running Horse would then be worn by the Governor and would be passed on the future Governors with their sashes and insignia. 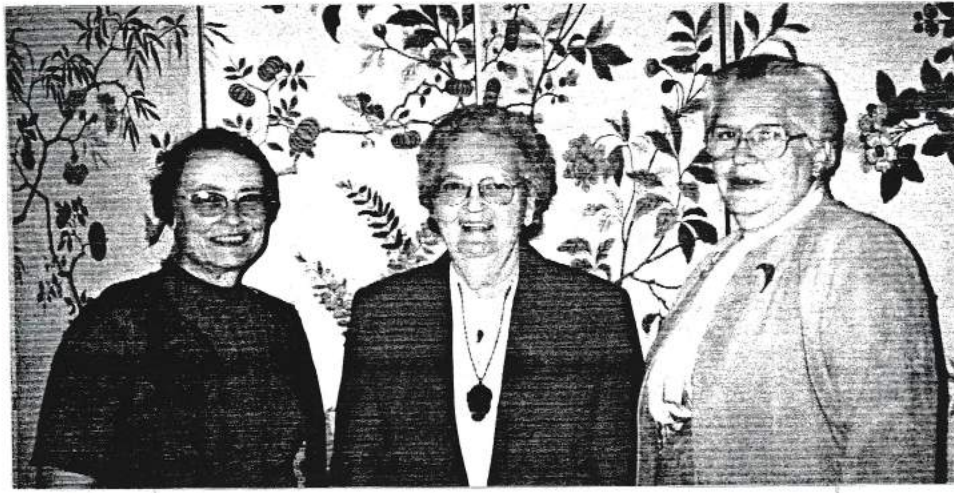
